Treasurer's Report:

Chief Riley presented the Treasurer's Report. One item that was omitted from the new budget was the annual fee for the Division 10 Website. There is enough funds to include it in the budget under "Miscellaneous" for \$2,040.00. With no questions, Chief Buckley asked for a motion to approve the January 2025 Treasurer's report. Motion was made by Brookfield, seconded by McCook. All were in favor. The motion carried.

Vice President's Report:

Chief Brenn discussed the HazMat box card template as it relates to Division 16. The consensus is that if a Division 10 agency wants to have a Division 16 agency respond prior to a box alarm that is their prerogative. Once we get to the box alarm level, however we should remove Division 16 agencies and it was recommended to move them to the 2-11 level.
