Chief Brenn called the meeting to order at 9:09 am.

Chief Brenn asked for a moment of silence for the [0] firefighter fatalities reported by the USFA in 2026 and for all of 2025.

Presentation/Adoption of Previous Meeting Minutes:

Chief Brenn presented the meeting minutes from the December 10th, 2025, meeting.

Lyons made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Seconded by Pleasantview. All were in favor. The motion carried.

President's Report:

Chief Brenn wanted to thank the past Executive Board Members, Chief Buckley, and Chief Lahanis. Chief Brenn welcomed the new members to the Executive Board: Chief DeLesche and Deputy Chief Donatucci. Chief Brenn congratulated Chief Argast (PLVW) on his upcoming retirement on January 30th, and Chief Adams (BRKD).

Treasurer's Report:

Chief Riley reported on two reports. November total was \$105,605.38. There were 2 deposits from associate members, and a few more are awaiting.

Motion to accept November's report. Riverside made a motion to accept, and Lagrange seconded the motion.

Decembers accounts were \$126,480.94.

Financial Summary as of December 31, 2025

The motion was moved by Riverside and seconded by Pleasantview.

Here's an update on the Sawyer/Falduto Investment account: There's a mismatch between the Division's Tax ID name and what the IRS has on file, so we're working to fix that. Sawyer/Falduto won't open the account until the name and ID match, since there's a conflict tied to the old Cook County and Division 10 names. We're actively resolving it now.
